## Notes regarding the Show

1. The Organizing Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry and to amalgamate/ change, cancel or postpone any classes should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
2. The Organizing Committee of BSJA Jersey accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Local competitors taking part in the show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey. Competitive Non-Jumping members may enter only the Showing Classes and Heights Classes as stipulated in the schedule. Headgear must comply with British Showjumping Rules.
4. All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over and (except those competing in unaffiliated and showing classes only) registered with BSJA Jersey or BSJA Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing British Showjumping Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules.
5. Visiting riders from outside Jersey must take out temporary membership of BSJA Jersey, valid for this show only, and declare their horse / pony winnings in accordance with their prevailing registration body.
6. Visiting horses and ponies should divide their current winnings by 3 to convert pounds to points.
7. All British Showjumping Rules from the prevailing Rule Book as amended and 2010 Local Rules apply. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter a class.
8. All trophies to be returned to the Clubhouse on Entries Night, clean and engraved. Failure to return a trophy will result in entries being refused.
9. Entries will be taken at the Clubhouse on Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> June between 7pm and 9pm. Postal entries, no later than Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> June to Mrs M Pichler, La Poste, La Rue de Flicquet, St Martin, JE3 6BP. Late entries will be accepted at the Showground, up until the start of the previous class with the exception of Classes 1- 4 (see note 10) at a cost of £4 over and above the normal entry fee. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.4.
10. NB: Late entries for **Friday evening** will only be accepted by telephone on Thursday, 24 June by calling 855972 between 7-9 pm and entries will not be taken on the Showground for Friday Evening. A late entry fee of £4.00 will be applied and payment must be made before jumping on Friday evening.
11. Ponies with over 16 points (£50) winnings must have a current JMB Height Certificate.
12. Horses and ponies may only enter **THREE** classes per day

**Rules for GRAND PRIX Classes (Classes 17, 23, 24)**

This is a three round competition. All horses/ponies jumping clear in the first round or, if there are fewer than 10 clear rounds, the 10 horses/ponies with the least number of faults go forward to the second round, carrying any faults incurred with them. Round two is jumped over a puissance-type course of single fences, not against the clock. Horses/ponies with the highest number of faults in the first round will jump first, followed by those with the next highest and so on. If there is equality of faults after the second round, there will be a jump-off over a shortened first course. Lower placings will be decided first on the total number of faults, then on the time taken in the first round.
