In the event of insufficient entries to make up a class ,ie less than 4, (Rule 76.14) then competitors wishing to jump at a higher level will be allowed to have a schooling round at a cost of £4 per round.

Grading points will be awarded for classes 2 to 9 inclusive in accordance with local rules and provided competitors achieve a clear in the first round (or either section of Single Phase), with the exception of qualifiers where a double clear must be achieved - **Prize money will be awarded in accordance with Rule 76.6**
