CONDITIONS AND RULES: In accordance with the prevailing BS Rule and Year Book (as updated) and 2011 Local Rules and Pony Club Rules for Classes 5-9

1. Horses and ponies competing in any jumping competitions (except Class 27) on 4 & 5 June must be registered with BSJA Jersey Branch, the property of members and to be ridden by members of BSJA Jersey Branch or their local federation. Visiting riders from outside the Channel Islands must take out visiting membership at a cost of £10.00 valid for this show only. Classes 5-9 are only open to current members of JDH Pony Club or visiting branches, mounted on horses or ponies
2. For insurance purposes, any showing, first ridden, leading rein or intro unaffiliated rider who is not a member of either BSJA Jersey Branch or JDH Pony Club must take out temporary membership of BSJA Jersey (£5) for this show – see entry form.
3. Riders competing in leading rein classes may **only compete in LR Classes**. They should be led by a **responsible adult** and must remain on the leading rein **at all times**. Neckstraps recommended for pole class
4. No nomination entries will be accepted. The Organisers reserves the right to amalgamate/divide classes dependant on entries.
5. Late entries will be accepted up to the start of the previous class **OR** by telephone to Mrs J Spence on 862540 on Wednesday and Thursday 1st/2nd June between 7 pm and 9 pm **only**. A charge of £3.00 over and above the normal entry fee will be made
6. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.4.
7. In the event of insufficient starters, lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6.
8. Trophies to be returned to **MRS JANE SEBIRE** at Bon Air Stables, St Lawrence by **SUNDAY 8th MAY 2011**, clean and in good condition. **NO** entries will be accepted from persons failing to comply. Trophies to be collected from the Secretary's office - Winners are responsible for engraving and safekeeping of all trophies.
9. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to the Show ground. Motor bikes, mopeds and bicycles may not be ridden inside the Showground.
10. Dogs must remain on the lead at all times. The Organisers reserves the right to ask owners to remove dogs from the Show ground.
11. In the event of a Competitor being required in 2 rings simultaneously, that Competitor may only compete in one class and therefore must choose in which class they wish to compete, automatically retiring from the other Ring.
12. Competitors are asked to ride with due consideration for others on the Show ground at all times and to **walk** between the rings, collecting rings and trailer park.
13. Legal liability – neither the Organisers nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to competitors, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
14. Health & Safety – The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable care to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all officials and stewards.
15. Stallions – No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury. Stallions must be identified on entry forms, should wear a bridle at all times and, in addition to the two bridle discs must wear a red ribbon in the tail at all times
16. Registered ponies may not compete in Show/Working Hunter or Riding Horse classes.
