Notes regarding the show

1. The Organizing Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry and amalgamate, change or cancel any class should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
2. The Organizing Committee or BSJA Jersey accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Local competitors taking part in the show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey.
4. All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over and registered with BSJA Jersey or BSJA Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing BS Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules.
5. Riders from outside Jersey must take out visiting Membership at a cost of £10, valid for this show only and declare their horse / pony winnings in accordance with their prevailing registration body. Visiting horses should divide their current winnings by 3 to convert pounds to points.
6. Ponies with over £50 actual or (16 Jsy points) winnings must have a current JMB Height Certificate
7. All Rules from the 2011 British Showjumping Rule Book as amended and 2011 Local Rules.
8. **Entries** will be taken at the **Clubhouse on Tuesday 30th August** between **6.30 pm and 8.00 pm**. **Postal entries** may be sent **before** Entries Night to Mrs Margaret Pichler, La Poste, Rue de Flicquet, St Martin, JE3 6BP by Friday, 26th August 2011. Late entries will be accepted at the Showground, up until the start of the previous class, at a cost of £4 over and above the normal entry fee with the exception of upgrading or late qualifiers for SJOY. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.4.
9. In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6
10. All **trophies** to be returned to the Clubhouse on **Entries Night**. Failure to return trophies will result in competitors not being allowed to participate.
11. Lists of qualifying horses and ponies will be on display in the Clubhouse. **Competitors must enter the Grade in which they jumped their last double clear round, with the exception of Horses qualifying with 0-33 points, who may enter Class 23 or Class 24.** In the event that only one horse/pony is entered in a Show Jumper of the Year Class that horse/pony must jump two rounds without being eliminated to receive an award
12. Horses and Ponies may only enter TWO jumping classes per day.

RULES FOR SPECIAL COMPETITONS

Rules for **CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES** – run under Table A9. (CLASSES 6 and 7). At the conclusion of the first round, all clear rounds or, if there are less than 8 clear rounds, those 8 with the least faults in the first round will qualify to go forward to the jump-off. If there is a tie for 8th place, the fastest competitor will qualify. The order of going in the jump-off will be in reverse order of penalties (and time from the first round, in the case of equality of faults). Final placings will be determined by adding together faults incurred in both rounds. In case of equality of faults, the fastest time in the jump-off will determine the final placings. Lower placings for competitors not taking part in the jump-off will depend on the faults and time (in the case of equality) in the first round

Rules for **ERASER CLASSES** (CLASSES 8 and 9) These competitions will be run as Table A4 with the exception that for the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle will be provided. The alternative obstacle will be not less than 10 cms and not more than 15 cms greater on height and will be known as the “Eraser Fence”. Each competitor may then choose to jump one or other of the alternatives which form the last obstacle. Any competitor who has incurred faults prior to the last obstacle and who chooses to jump the “Eraser Fence” and jumps it clear will then have four faults “erased” from his/her total score for his/her round (i.e. a four fault round prior to the last obstacle will then count as a clear, an eight fault round prior to the last obstacle will be reduced to a four fault total). Any error incurred whilst jumping the “Eraser Fence” will be penalised in faults in the same manner as for any normal fence (i.e. a knockdown will incur four faults and will be added to the penalties incurred prior to jumping the “Eraser Fence”). The choice to jump the “Eraser Fence” is entirely at the discretion of the competitor and there will be no signal made to inform the rider whether or not he/she has incurred faults in his/her round prior to the last fence. Placings will be determined on faults and time after any adjustments have been made for successfully jumping the “Eraser Fence”.

Rules for **GRAND PRIX CLASSES** – (CLASSES 15-18 and 21-24) This is a three round competition. All horses/ponies jumping clear in the first round or, if there are fewer than 8 clear rounds, the 8 horses/ponies with the least number of faults go forward to the second round, carrying any faults incurred with them. Round two is jumped over a puissance-type course of single fences, not against the clock. Horses/ponies with the highest number of faults in the first round will jump first, followed by those with the next highest and so on. If there is equality of faults after the second round, there will be a jump-off over a shortened first course. Lower placings will be decided first on the total number of faults, then on the time taken in the first round.
