1. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to amalgamate/change, cancel or postpone any Classes should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
2. The Organising Committee and BSJA Jersey accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Local competitors taking part in the show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey.
4. All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over (foaled in or after 2014) and registered with BSJA Jersey or British Showjumping Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing British Showjumping Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules.
5. Visiting riders from outside Jersey must take out temporary membership of BSJA Jersey, valid for this show only, and declare their horse / pony winnings in accordance with their prevailing registration body.
6. All British Showjumping Rules from the prevailing Rule Book as amended and 2018 Local Rules apply. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter a Class.
7. In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes maybe withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6.
8. In accordance with Rule 45.7 Ponies with over 150 points winnings must have a current JMB Height Certificate.
9. Please see schedule regarding the number of Classes that may be entered by horses and ponies on each day.
10. All **trophies** to be returned to Natalie Quenault, clean and engraved. Failure to return a trophy will result in entries being refused and a fine being levied.
11. **Entries** can be made online www.bsjajersey.com before 15 June 2018. Late entries, which will incur a late entry fee of £5 per class, will be accepted at the Showground, up until the start of the previous Class. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.4.

ERASER CLASS 25

These competitions will be run as Table A4 with the exception that for the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle will be provided. The alternative obstacle will be not less than 10 cms and not more than 15 cms greater on height and will be known as the "Eraser Fence". Each competitor may then choose to jump one or other of the alternatives which form the last obstacle. Any competitor who has incurred faults prior to the last obstacle and who chooses to jump the "Eraser Fence" and jumps it clear will then have four faults "erased" from his/her total score for his/her round (i.e. a four fault round prior to the last obstacle will then count as a clear, an eight fault round prior to the last obstacle will be reduced to a four fault total). Any error incurred whilst jumping the "Eraser Fence" will be penalised in faults in the same manner as for any normal fence (i.e. a knockdown will incur four faults and will be added to the penalties incurred prior to jumping the "Eraser Fence"). The choice to jump the "Eraser Fence" is entirely at the discretion of the competitor and there will be no signal made to inform the rider whether or not he/she has incurred faults in his/her round prior to the last fence. Placings will be determined on faults and time after any adjustments have been made for successfully jumping the "Eraser Fence".

DODSON & HORRELL 85CM NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER – 1ST ROUND

For Registered Horses to be ridden by members excluding any rider on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2016 and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2016. Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team, (Nations Cup, World, European Championships and Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible. (Excluding Veteran Teams)

Rule 318 Table A7, Single Phase or Two Phase Speed 325mpm

Those horses which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in one Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur First Round competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in any of the Dodson & Horrell National Amateur 85cms Second Round competitions, irrespective of their placing for prize money in those competitions. Those horses which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur Championship

DODSON & HORRELL 1.10M NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER – 1ST ROUND

For Registered Horses ridden by members excluding any rider on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2016. Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team, (Nations Cup, World, European Championships and Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible. (Excluding Veteran Teams)

Rule 324 Table A10 Speed: 325mpm

Numbers to qualify: (For First Round competitions scheduled from 1st Sept 2016) Those horses which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in one Dodson & Horrell 1.10m National Amateur First Round competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in any of the Dodson & Horrell National Amateur 1.10m Second Round competitions, irrespective of their placing for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191) Horses in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear in order to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Dodson & Horrell 1.10m National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Those horses which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five Dodson & Horrell 1.10m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Dodson & Horrell 1.10m National Amateur Championship.

EQUITOP MYOPLAST SENIOR FOXHUNTER – FIRST ROUND

Rule 310. Table A7. Speed: 350mpm

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 310.6.

b) For all horses that are seven years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with Rule 310.6.

Qualifies for: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior Foxhunter First Round competitions in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money. Horses in the class must go into the jump off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular First Round Foxhunter competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

(A Senior 1.20m Open may be combined with a Foxhunter competition. In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may only compete in one section. Alternatively a Grade C may be combined with a Foxhunter competition and one set of prize money will be awarded)
