Notes regarding the Show

THIS SHOW IS OPEN TO ALL BSJA AND JRC MEMBERS, IF YOU ARE NOT A MEMBER OF EITHER BSJA OR JRC, THEN YOU MAY TAKE OUT A DAY MEMBERSHIP TO BSJA for £10

1. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to amalgamate/change, cancel or postpone any Classes should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
2. The Organising Committee and BSJA Jersey accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Local competitors taking part in the show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey or Jersey Riding Club or take out day membership for £10. Showing competitors please note that headgear must comply with British Showjumping Rules.(Rule 101.3).
4. All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over (foaled in or after 2014) and registered with BSJA Jersey or British Showjumping Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing British Showjumping Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules.
5. Visiting riders from outside Jersey must take out temporary membership of BSJA Jersey, valid for this show only, and declare their horse / pony winnings in accordance with their prevailing registration body.
6. All British Showjumping Rules from the prevailing Rule Book as amended and 2018 Local Rules apply. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter a Class.
7. In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes maybe withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6.
8. In accordance with Rule 45.7 Ponies with over 150 points winnings must have a current JMB Height Certificate.
9. All **trophies** to be returned to Natalie Quenault, clean and engraved. Failure to return a trophy will result in entries being refused and a fine being levied.
10. **Entries** can be made online www.bsjajersey.com before 29 June 2018 Late entries, which will incur a late entry fee of £5 per class, will be accepted at the Showground, up until the start of the previous Class. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.4.

| Class 1 | IN HAND OPEN PONY. Not exc 148cm. (The organisers reserve the right to request that small handlers be assisted by a responsible adult) | |
| Class 2 | VETERAN PONY (ridden) Open to ponies not exc 148cm aged 16 years and over. Riders' ages to conform to usual age/height restrictions | |
| Class 3 | BEST CHILD'S PONY Not exc 128cm Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm. Riders born in or after 2006 | |
| Class 4 | BEST CHILD'S PONY not exc. 148 cm Open to ponies exceeding 128cm and not exceeding 148cm Riders born in or after 2004 (not exc 138cm) and 2002 (not exc 148cm) respectively. Separate trophies for best 138cm and 148cm ponies <i>Only overall 1ST & 2ND place winners eligible for the Championship</i> | |
| Class 5 | BEST COLOURED PONY Not exc. 148cm To include Piebalds, Skewbalds and Appaloosas. The white patch must be on the horse's body, above the level of the stifle or elbow, excluding any facial markings Riders' ages to conform to usual age/height restrictions, leading reins permitted. | |
| Class 6 | CHILD'S PONY CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1 st & 2 nd prize-winners in Classes 3-5 | |
| Class 7 | LEADING REIN PONY Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm led by responsible adult. Riders born in or after 2009 | |
| Class 8 | FIRST RIDDEN PONY Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm. Preference will be given to ponies ridden in a snaffle bridle. Riders must be born in or after 2008. No cantering except in individual show (optional). | |
| Class 9 | NURSERY/FIRST RIDDEN WORKING HUNTER PONY Open to ponies not exc.128cm. Rider born in or after 2008 for First Ridden, 2009 for Lead Rein This class may be split if sufficient entries NB: Riders must be capable of completing the whole course at rising trot. | |
| Class 10 | MINI CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st & 2nd prize winners in Classes 7,8 and 9 | |
| Class 11 | PONY CLUB PONY To be judged on performance, manners and suitability. Pony Club turnout - jackets to be worn. Ponies will also be expected to jump 2 working hunter fences as part of their individual show. Section 1 60-65cm and Section 2 70-75cm Section 1: ponies not exc 128cm. Section 2: ponies exc 128cm but not exc 148cm. | |
| Class 12 | WORKING HUNTER PONY Open to ponies not exc. 128cm. Riders must be born in or after after 2006 (not exc 128cm) | 60-65 |
| Class 13 | NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY Open to ponies exc.128cm foaled in or after 2012 and ponies exc 128cm foaled before 2012 with 0-45 points which have not won ANY Open Working Hunter Pony Class or not more than 3 Novice WHP Classes. Riders' ages to follow usual Class divisions. | 70-75 |
| Class 14 | WORKING HUNTER PONY Open to ponies exceeding 128cm, not exceeding 148cm. Riders must be born in or after 2004(not exc 138) and 2002 (not exc 148cm) respectively. Separate trophies for best 138 and 148 ponies. <i>Only overall 1ST & 2ND place winners eligible for the Championship</i> <i>NB Ponies may only compete in 2 Working Hunter Pony Classes</i> | 80-85 |
| Class 15 | WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in Classes 12-14 | |

| Class 16 | OPEN IN HAND HORSE – Open to horses exc 148 cm. Competitors entering Class 16 will be given sufficient time to prepare their horse for the ridden Veteran Class | |
| Class 17 | VETERAN HORSE – RIDDEN Open to all horses aged 16 years and over | |
| Class 18 | RACEHORSE TO RIDING HORSE (ridden) – Open to registered racehorses that have raced under rules. | |
| Class 19 | OPEN RIDING HORSE Separate trophies will be presented to highest placed small and large riding horse. This class may be divided if sufficient entries. <i>Only overall 1ST & 2ND place winners eligible for the Championship</i> | |
| Class 20 | OPEN COB AND COLOURED HORSE To include Piebalds, Skewbalds and Appaloosas. The white patch must be on the horse's body, above the level of the stifle or elbow, excluding any facial markings. | |
| Class 21 | COB, COLOURED AND RIDING HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in Classes 18-20 | |
| Class 22 | SMALL SHOW HUNTER Open to horses not exceeding 158cm | |
| Class 23 | OPEN SHOW HUNTER Separate Trophies for Lightweight -i.e. horses capable of carrying up to 12st 7lbs and Middleweight horses capable of carrying over 12st 7lbs – please specify on entry form. This class may be divided if sufficient entries. <i>Only overall 1ST & 2ND place winners eligible for the Championship</i> | |
| Class 24 | SHOW HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in Classes 22-23 Also open to highest placed Best Young Hunter (foaled in 2014, 2013 or 2012) in Classes 22 and 23 – competitors eligible for this award should wear light armband) | |
| Class 25 | NOVICE WORKING HUNTER Open to <u>all</u> horses foaled in or after 2012 <u>and</u> horses with 0-45 points which have not won any Open working hunter and not more than 3 Novice working hunter Classes | 0.70-0.75 |
| Class 26 | SMALL WORKING HUNTER Open to horses not exceeding 158cm. | 0.85-0.90 |
| Class 27 | LARGE WORKING HUNTER Open to horses exceeding 158cm | 0.85-0.90 |
| Class 28 | OPEN WORKING HUNTER Open to registered horses | 1.00-1.05 |
