1. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to amalgamate/change, cancel or postpone any Classes should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
2. The Organising Committee and BSJA Jersey accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Local competitors taking part in the show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey or take out day membership for showing on Saturday 5 May or Sunday 6 May. Showing competitors please note that headgear must comply with British Showjumping Rules.(Rule 101.3)
4. All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over (foaled in or after 2014) and registered with BSJA Jersey or British Showjumping Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing British Showjumping Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules.
5. Visiting riders from outside Jersey must take out temporary membership of BSJA Jersey, valid for this show only, and declare their horse / pony winnings in accordance with their prevailing registration body.
6. All British Showjumping Rules from the prevailing Rule Book as amended and 2018 Local Rules apply. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter a Class.
7. In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes maybe withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6
8. In accordance with Rule 45.7 Ponies with over 150 points winnings must have a current JMB Height Certificate.
9. Please see schedule regarding the number of Classes that may be entered by horses and ponies on each day
10. All **trophies** to be returned to Natalie Quenault, clean and engraved. Failure to return a trophy will result in entries being refused and a fine being levied.
11. **Entries** can be made online www.bsjajersey.com before 27 April 2018 Late entries, which will incur a late entry fee of £5 per class, will be accepted at the Showground, up until the start of the previous Class. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.4.

Points Awards – to be awarded at the End of Season Prizegiving

- The **Lady Tic Tac Trophy** presented by the late **Miss V Durell** will be awarded to the horse with over 125 grading points gaining the highest number of points in both showing and jumping Classes.
- The **Miss Turfax Memorial Sash of Honour** presented by **Mrs. Sandra Hansford** will be awarded to the **Leading Senior Show Jumper** for the highest number of points gained on one horse in **Jumping Classes** only.
- The **Leading Senior Rider Sash of Honour** will be presented by **BSJA Jersey** for the highest number of points gained on one horse in both **Showing and Jumping** Classes.
- The **Leading Junior Rider Sash of Honour** will be presented by **BSJA Jersey** for the highest number of points gained on one 148cm pony in both **Showing and Jumping** Classes.
- The **Leading 128cm Rider Sash of Honour** will be presented by **BSJA Jersey** for the highest number of points gained on one 128cm pony in both **Showing and Jumping** Classes.

Horses and ponies do not have to compete in showing Classes to be eligible for the Leading Rider awards.

Points gained in Show Hunter Classes and Championships at Liberation Day and Members Day Horse Show will count towards the **Royal Mint Trophy** presented by **Mr and Mrs P Horsfall**.

The **John Hinault Junior and Senior Trophies** will be presented at the end of the season to the junior and senior riders gaining the highest number of points on one horse or pony at Liberation Day and Members Day Horse Shows.

TEAM JUMPING: Classes 41 AND 65

Inter-insular team jumping will be held in accordance with Rule 281, with the exception of Rule 281.7 which for these purposes will read as follows: *“In a team of four riders, if one member is eliminated then that score is discounted. If a second member is eliminated then that horse/rider combination is awarded 20 faults plus the faults incurred by the worst horse in any team in that round.”*

CHALLENGE CLASS – Class 48 and 62

This class is run on the basis of the “Hickstead Masters” and is a one round class but in two sections (A & B).

First section (A) will be run over a course of 8-10 fences including a minimum of two doubles and will be judged under Table C. Approx Height Ponies 0.85cm). Competitors will register a time for the first section (A) and then proceed immediately on to the second section (B).

The finish flags for Section (A) and the start flags for section (B) will be placed together after the last jumping effort of Section (A).

Section (B) will consist of four vertical fences numbered 1-4, preferably in a straight line (on related distances) and of similar appearance. The fences will be built ascending in height from fence 1 to fence 4. (for example Ponies: 0.85/0.90/95/1.00). Section (B) will be judged under Table A.

Placings will be decided on faults incurred in section (B) and time recorded for section (A).

Start and finish flags must denote the start and finish of each section.

KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship – First Round

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2014 irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final – in accordance with Rule 316.6 2

Table: A7, Two Phase (Rule 286) or Single Phase (Rule 287). 3 Speed: 325m per minute. Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1 May - 30 April inclusive.

Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the Class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification.

DODSON & HORRELL 85CM NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER – 1ST ROUND

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period).

Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Table: A7, Two Phase or Single Phase. Qualifies for 85cm National Amateur Second Rounds. Qualifying period yearly 1 September - 31 August inclusive. Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 85cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 85cm Second Round competition.

DODSON & HORRELL 95CM NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER - 1ST ROUND

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). and any horse/ rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League of 31st March 2017 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Table: A7, Two Phase or Single Phase. Qualifies for: 95cm National Amateur Second Rounds. Qualifying period yearly 1 September - 31 August inclusive. 6 Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 95cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships.

Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 95cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 95cm Second Round competition

DODSON & HORRELL 1.05M NATIONAL AMATEUR QUALIFIER – 1ST ROUND

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2016 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible. (Excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 1.05m National Amateur Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.05m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.05m Second Round competition.

The winner of a particular 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

EQUITOP MYOPLAST SENIOR FOXHUNTER – FIRST ROUND

Horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. (a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 310.6 or (b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2011, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with Rule 310.6

Table: A7, Single Phase or Two Phase. A water tray or water type jump compulsory being minimum spread 1.20m (4ft), maximum spread 3m (10ft) outdoors 2.75m (9ft indoors) with at least two poles over and a Water Jump type take off element in front must be in all outdoor Foxhunter First Round Competitions

Qualifies for: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round Qualifying period 1 June - 31 May inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior Foxhunter First Round competitions in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go into the jump off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification
