## Saturday 9 June 2018

- Class 1      Lead Rein Pony open to ponies not exceeding 123 cm (12.0). Riders aged 9 and under.
- Class 2      Lead Rein Pony open to ponies exceeding 123cm (12.2) but not exceeding 128 cm (12.2). Riders aged 9 and under.
- Class 3      First Ridden Pony not exceeding 128 cm. Riders to be 9 years or under on day of Show.
- Class 4      First Ridden Pony not exceeding 148 cm. Riders to be 10-12 years on day of Show.
- Class 5      Mini Championship Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize-winners in Class 1 2 3 and 4
- Class 6      Family Pony – Ponies must not exceed 128 cm. The first rider must be lead rein; the second rider must be off the lead rein (ie First Ridden). Both riders will be asked to give a small show to determine the suitability of the pony on and off the lead rein.
- Class 7      Best Lead Rein Rider – Ponies not exceeding 128 cm. Riders 9 years and under.
- Class 8      Best First Ridden Riders – Ponies not exceeding 128 cm. Open to First Ridden Riders
- Class 9      Lead Rein Working Hunter Pony – Ponies not exceeding 128 cm. Rider to be 9 years and under on day of show.
- Class 10     First Ridden Working Hunter Pony – Ponies not exceeding 128 cm. Rider to be 9 years and under on day of Show.
- Class 11     First Ridden Working Hunter Pony – Ponies not exceeding 148 cm – Rider to be 10 – 12 years on day of show.
- Class 12     Working Hunter Pony Championship – Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize-winners in Classes 9, 10 and 11
