

SHOWJUMPER OF THE YEAR

Qualifying Classes/Championships

In recent years it has been noted that it can be difficult to qualify for Showjumper of the Year (SJOY) and we have been reviewing the qualifying criteria and format of this Championship Show to make it a fitting finale to our season and recognition of members' achievements during the year.

Therefore in 2017, SJOY will offer three separate championships which should offer more competitors the opportunity to qualify for a championship final at this prestigious event

The three championship finals will be as follows:

1 BDO SATOR REGULATORY CONSULTING LIMITED VICTOR LUDORUM

We are delighted that Sator Regulatory Consulting Limited has once again kindly agreed to sponsor this series. The format will be the same as in previous years with both pony and senior riders taking the opportunity to enter qualifiers at our shows and gain points. The top 8 pony and horse/rider combinations on the points table will be invited to participate in their respective final at SJOY. Pony courses will be set at 0.95m, Horse courses at 1.05m.

Horses and ponies may only be ridden in the final of the above competition by the rider gaining qualification points. In the event of a horse/pony changing rider during the course of the season, then that new combination's points will be calculated separately.

2 SHOW JUMPER OF THE YEAR – Graded Championships

Throughout the 2017 season, classes at the specified grades, ie 128cm/JD/JC/JA for ponies and Novice / Grade C / Grade B / Grade A for horses, will be marked as Qualifiers (SJOYQ) for the Showjumper of the Year Finals. To qualify for these finals, competitors must be Channel Island residents and must place 1st – 4th in a designated qualifying classes (having jumped clear in the first round) held at a British Showjumping Jersey Show in 2017.

Horses and ponies will compete in the championship final in accordance with their prevailing grade.

Horses and ponies may only be ridden in the finals of the above competitions by a rider who met the qualification criteria on that horse or pony unless there has been a change of registered ownership during the course of the season.

3 BRONZE, SILVER AND GOLD LEAGUES

A new series of league classes are being introduced culminating in a final at SJOY whereby competitors may choose the level at which they compete, irrespective of their horse/pony grading (exc 128cm).

League qualifying classes will be scheduled during the 2017 season, at the respective heights as detailed below and, in addition to grading points, league points will be awarded.

In this inaugural year, the heights for each league have been set as follows

SENIORS

- Gold League 1.10
- Silver League 1.00
- Bronze League 0.90

JUNIORS

- Junior Gold 0.85
- Junior Silver 0.75
- 128cm Bronze 0.65

League points will be awarded in the featured league Qualifier class; league points can also be gained for those jumping double clear in classes outside the designated heights. Competitors can maximise the opportunity to gain league points by competing in the appropriate qualifying classes at each show. Only two classes per day will be eligible for the awarding of points.

Qualifying classes will be marked on the schedule with the appropriate designation eg: GQ, SQ or BQ.

In accordance with rule 76.5, all horse/rider combinations being placed 7th or below, will receive the same points as those allocated to 6th place. All competitors achieving double clears will be awarded 5 points.

Competitors may compete and earn points towards whichever league class they choose, but may only compete in one championship final (e Gold, Silver or Bronze) at the year- end Show. The top 10 horse and rider combinations in each league will be eligible to compete in that league final.

League points are gained by specific horse and rider combinations and are not transferrable. In the event of a horse/pony changing rider during the course of the season, then that new combination's points will be calculated separately.

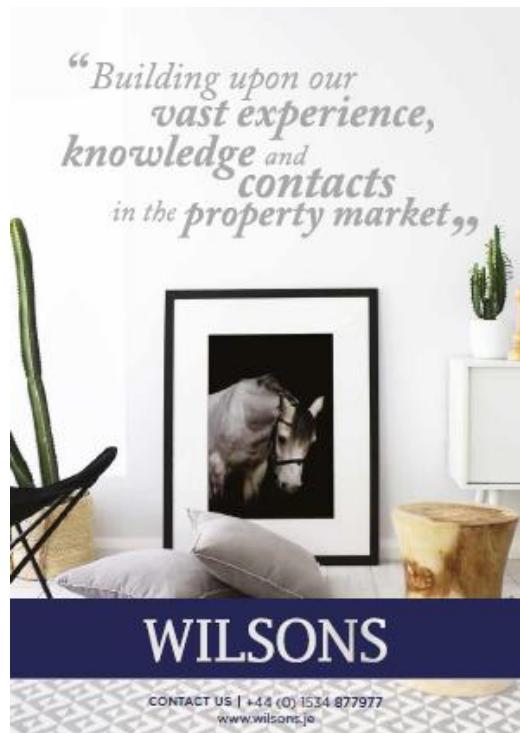
