The Show Committee/Organisers and/or land owners accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons animals or vehicles resulting from the show.

For insurance purposes any competitor who is not a member of BSJA Jersey must take out a BSJA Show Membership at a cost of £5.00.

The Show Committee reserve the right to refuse any entries, amalgamate, amend cancel or split any class if deemed necessary. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the Class to the Secretary's Caravan. In all disputes, the Show Committee's decision will be final.

Health & Safety – There will be qualified First Aiders and Child Protection Officers on the Showground. The Organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable care to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must comply with the instructions of the Organisers and all officials/Stewards. Please also take note of the signs displayed on the Showground. **Regulation** Hard Hats must be worn whilst mounted as specified in the BSJA 2011 Rule Book.

All Jumping Classes are **UNAFFILIATED** but we reserve the right to use/comply with the BSJA 2011 Rule Book and 2011 Local Rules. **All** horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or over and be either mares or geldings.

No Motorbikes, Mopeds, or Bicycles should be ridden on the Show Ground and Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and owners must clean up after their dogs.

NURSERY/NOVICE Classes are for 128cm competitors either aged 10 (born in or after 2001) and under or ponies with 0-20 points with riders born in or after 1999. All ponies must be ridden by riders of the correct age to height of pony, except for Classes 53-56 in the West Ring. **PONY** means exceeding 128cm not exceeding 148cm.

Points Trophies – A maximum of 3 classes per day will count towards the overall points for the Show

Rules for GRAND PRIX Classes This is a three round competition. All horses/ponies jumping clear in the first round or, if there are fewer than 10 clear rounds, the 10 horses/ponies with the least number of faults go forward to the second round, carrying any faults incurred with them. Round two is jumped over a puissance-type course of single fences, not against the clock. Horses/ponies with the highest number of faults in the first round will jump first, followed by those with the next highest and so on. If there is equality of faults after the second round, there will be a jump-off over a shortened first course. Lower placings will be decided first on the total number of faults, then on the time taken in the first round.

Rules for Raise A Fence – The course will be made up of six fences one of which will be a double. Seven competitors qualify to take part from a preceding A4 competition. Each competitor chooses a fence to raise by one hole - in the first round a difference fence must be chosen by each competitor. All clear rounds go through to the next round and in subsequent rounds competitors may choose to raise any fence. If a competitor faults they are automatically retired and their selected fence is reinstated. There will be a maximum of five rounds each round is drawn. The winner is the last person to jump clear in the final round.
