Notes Regarding the show

- 1) The organising committee reserve the right to refuse any entry and to amalgamate/change, cancel or postpone any classes should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
- 2) The organising committee of BSJA Jersey accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to person, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
- 3) Local competitors taking part in the show jumping must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey. Headgear must comply with British Show Jumping Rules.
- 4) All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over and registered with BSJA Jersey or BSJA Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing British Show Jumping Rules and 2011 BSJA Jersey Local rules.
- 5) All British Show Jumping rules from the prevailing rule book as amended and 2011 local rules apply. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter a class.
- 6) Entries will be taken at the BSJA clubhouse on Monday 4th July between 7pm and 9pm. Postal entries, no later than Friday 1st July to Mrs Pat Billington, 2 Blair Adam House, Les Chenolles, St John, JE3 4FB
- 7) Late entries will be accepted at the Trinity Manor showground, up until the start of the previous class, at a cost of £4 over and above the normal entry fee. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.4.
- 8) All dogs must be kept on leads
- 9) **Eraser class rules:** this competition will be run as table A4 with the exception that for the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle will be provided. The alternative obstacle will be not less than 10cms and not more than 15cms greater on height and will be known as the 'Eraser Fence' Any competitor who has incurred faults prior to the last obstacle and who chooses to jump the Eraser Fence and jumps it clear will then have four faults erased from their total score. Any error incurred whilst jumping the Eraser fence will be penalised in faults
- 10) **Senior Masters class rules:** The First jumping round will be a qualifying round (table A4) and the top 8 competitors will go into next round. Each subsequent round is then drawn. There will be 7 fences, one of which will be a double. The first competitor must elect to raise a fence by one hole. Faults will result in the elected fence being restored to its previous height and the competitor retiring. In the first round no fence may be raised more than once until all 8 fences have been raised. Competitors jumping clear will go into the final rounds and may raise any fence they wish. Max of 4 rounds. On equality clear rounds will jump against the clock.
- 11) **Snooker Competition Rules:** This is a competition, against the clock, based on the game of snooker, with a time allowed of 60 seconds. The competitor scoring the greatest number of points in the fastest time will be the winner. The course will consist of nine single fences and the fences will increase in difficulty according to their value. There will be three red fences (value 1 point) and one fence each of yellow (2 pts), green (3 pts), brown (4 pts), blue (5 pts), pink (6 points) and black (7 pts). Competitors are placed on points. In the event of equality of points, time will decide.

When the bell is rung, the competitor will cross the starting line in either direction and will jump a red fence followed by any coloured fence of his/her choice. This is followed by a further red fence and then any coloured fence until all three red fences and any three coloured fences have been jumped. **Each red fence may only be jumped once.** The competitor will then jump the yellow, green, brown, blue, pink, and black fences in that sequence omitting any that may have been knocked down previously. Fences may be jumped in **either direction.** Rule 276.4,5 & 6 apply.

The competitor scores the number of points allotted to each obstacle jumped clear. At the end of 60 seconds, the bell will be rung and the competitor must pass through the finish in either direction. If a horse has already started to take off at the moment when the time allowed is reached, points will be awarded provided that obstacle is jumped clear.
