Class 5	Pairs Baton Relay - Pairs to be drawn. Competitors entering classes 3&4 will jump at 65cm, Competitors entering classes 6 & 7 will jump 85cm This class will not start before 12 noon	65cm/ 85cm
Class 6a	Table A7 Jumping - with TYOL (Take your own line) Jump off All competitors jumping clear in the first round will have the option to Take Their Own Line over the shortened course fences designated for the jump off. Fences must be jumped in the direction stated on the course plan.	80cm
Class 6b	Table A7 Jumping - TYOL Jump off - see above	90cm
Class 6c	Table A7 Jumping - TYOL Jump off - see above Competitors may enter <u>one</u> of classes 6a, b or c	1.00m
Class 7a	Accumulator with Joker, Rule 274	80cm
Class 7b	Accumulator with Joker, Rule 274	90cm
Class 7c	Accumulator with Joker. Rule 274 Competitors may enter <u>one</u> of classes 7a, b or c	1.00m

Competitors may enter two classes and one baton relay for a blanket entry fee: £15 for BSJA members
£18 for JRC members

Or
Individual classes may be entered : BSJA members: £6 per class , JRC members: £7 per class

To encourage integration between our two clubs, the organizing committee will randomly select JRC/BSJA members to form teams and points will be awarded for each team member in their individual classes on a sliding scale of 6pts for a win down to 1pt for a 6th place. The team with the most points at the end of the day will win a prize.

Come and help course build at 2.30pm at BSJA field on Saturday, 1st October followed by complimentary tea/coffee and cake when we draw our teams!
