- CLASS 1 JERSEY SENIOR TRAILBLAZER** – Open to senior jumping, senior non-jumping and junior associate members riding registered or unregistered horses. *This is a one round competition with an optimum time for novice riders and/or inexperienced horses and to encourage new members.* Speed 325mpm (0.80m)
In case of elimination, a competitor may opt to restart the course without leaving the arena. This will incur an additional entry fee but will not be judged as having been jumped hors concours. Horses will be placed on their time and faults in the first round.
- CLASS 2 OPEN DOUBLE ACCUMULATOR** - Open to all registered horses. Local Rule Speed 325 mpm. (0.85m)
- CLASS 3 DERBY HOUSE BRITISH NOVICE CHAMPIONSHIP** – Single Phase Rule 316 +287
Speed 325mpm. Open to horses with 0-33 points.

Entry Fee: £7 Prize Money: £18 £12, £10, £8, £7 (0.90m)
- CLASS 4 SENIOR RESTRICTED SINGLE PHASE JUMPING** – Open to horses in Grade C with 0-59 points. Rule 287 Speed 325 mpm. (0.95m)
- CLASS 5 EQUISSAGE DISCOVERY CHAMPIONSHIP** – Table A7 Rule 314 Speed 325mpm.
1st 3 Rosettes by Equissage
Open to horse with 0 – 59 points. Entry Fee: £7 Prize Money: £18, £12, £10, £8, £7 (1.00m)
- CLASS 6 SENIOR OPEN SINGLE PHASE** - Open to horses in Grades C , B and A Rule 287
Speed 350 mpm. (1.05m)
- CLASS 7 TRI-ZONE SENIOR NEWCOMERS & 1.10M OPEN** –Table A7 Rule 312 Speed 350mpm 1st Rosette by Tri-zone
Entry Fee: £7 Prize Money: £18, £12, £10, £8, £7 (1.10m)
- CLASS 8 SENIOR OPEN SINGLE PHASE** - Open to horse in Grades C & B and A with 0-100 points. Speed 350 mpm. Table A7. (1.15m)
- CLASS 9 SENIOR OPEN A4 JUMPING** – Open to horses in Grades C, B and A. Speed 400 mpm. Table A4 (1.15m)
- CLASS 10 HORSE & HOUND FOXHUNTER & 1.20 OPEN** –. Table A7. Speed 350mpm
1st Rosette by Horse and Hound
Entry Fee: £7 Prize Money: £18, £12, £10, £8, £7 (1.20m)

In the event of insufficient entries to make up a class (ie less than 4) then competitors wishing to jump at a higher level will be allowed to have a schooling round at a cost of £3 per round.

Points will be awarded for classes 2 to 10 inclusive

Entry Fee for Class 1, - £4

Entry Fee for Classes 2 to10 - £7

Prize Money £18, £12, £10, £8, £7

Non-placing entries will be accepted for Classes 2, 3, 4, 5 & 8. Horse/rider combinations that enter a class as non-placing will not be placed in any subsequent classes on this day.
