Notes regarding the Show

1. The Organizing Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry and amalgamate or cancel any class should there be insufficient entries received.
2. The Organizing Committee or BSJA accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Jersey competitors taking part in the Show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey. Competitive Non-Jumping Members may only enter the Showing Classes and Classes 35 and 42.
4. **All** horses and ponies including visiting ones, must be four years and over and registered with the BSJA Jersey or BSJA Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the BSJA Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules. Visiting Riders from outside the Channel Islands must take out visiting Membership at a cost of £10, valid for this show only. Members of BSJA Guernsey must ensure that they have the appropriate insurance cover by joining either BSJA UK or BSJA Jersey as a visiting rider.
5. All BSJA Rules from the 2008 Rule Book and 2008 Local Rules.
6. All **entries** by post to **Mrs Gina Schiessl, Chaumiere de Haut, Rue de la Ville au Bas, St Lawrence, JE3 1EW**. Entries to be received by **Monday 16th June 2007** and **must** include the name, address and telephone number of a helper. **Please Note** Any postal entries received after this date will not be accepted. Late entries will be accepted at the showground up until the start of the previous class at a charge of £3 over and above the normal entry fee. Entries are not transferable from one class to another except for the purpose of upgrading. Refund of Entry Money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.5
7. All **trophies** to be returned to Miss Julie Lidgett at the Clubhouse on Monday 16th June 2008. Trophies returned after this date will be liable for a **fine of £50 per trophy**.
8. Spurs may not be worn in Pony Showing Classes.
9. Horses/Ponies may enter a maximum of three **(jumping)** classes per day. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure he/she is in the correct class.
10. Classes marked with a (Q) are Qualifying Competitions for Regional Finals and 2nd round competitions on the mainland in 2008.
11. Points will be awarded for each class on a sliding scale to count towards the following points awards. The **BSJA Jersey Sash of Honour** to the Senior rider gaining the highest number of points on one horse. The **Carlston Trophy** to the Junior rider gaining the highest number of points on one 148cm pony. The **Wilson Trophy** to the Junior rider gaining the highest number of points on one 128cm pony. The **BSJA Jersey Sash of Honour** to the Junior rider gaining the highest number of points on one pony. **Please Note: If competitors enter and place in more than two classes on any one day, only the best two results will count towards the points awards.**
12. Rules for Grand Prix Classes
This is a three round competition jumped under Table A. All horses/ponies jumping clear in the first round or, if there are fewer than 8 clear rounds, the 8 horses/ponies with the least number of faults go forward to the second round, carrying any faults incurred with them. Round two is jumped over a puissance-type course of single fences, not against the clock. Horses/ponies with the highest number of faults in the first round will jump first, followed by those with the next highest and so on. If there is equality of faults after the second round, there will be a jump-off against the clock over a shortened first course. Lower placings will be decided first on the total number of faults, then on the time taken in the first round.
13. A rider born in or after 1998 who competes in the Nursery Working Hunter Class on one pony may enter a 128cm Childs Pony or 128cm Working Hunter Pony class on a different pony, provided that rider does not compete in the Leading Rein or First Ridden classes.

SATURDAY 5TH JULY**9.00am**

- CLASS 1 **BEST CHILDS PONY** – Open to ponies exceeding 138cm, not exceeding 148cm, rider born in or after 1992.
- CLASS 2 **BEST CHILDS PONY**- Open to ponies exceeding 128cm, not exceeding 138cm, rider born in or after 1994
- CLASS 3 **BEST CHILDS PONY** – Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm. Rider born in or after 1996.
- CLASS 4 **BEST CHILDS PONY CHAMPIONSHIP**- Open to 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 1-3.
- CLASS 5 **LEADING REIN PONY** – Open to ponies not exceeding 123cm. Rider born in or after 1999. *Riders* in this class may not compete in any other showing class except for Class 6, 9, 10 and Classes 7 and 11 off the leading rein.
- CLASS 6 **LEADING REIN PONY** – Open to ponies exceeding 123cm, not exceeding 128cms. Rider born in or after 1999. *Riders* in this class may not compete in any other showing class except for Class 5, 9, 10, and Class 7 and 11 off the leading rein.
- CLASS 7 **FIRST RIDDEN PONY** - Not exceeding 128cm. Rider born in or after 1998. No cantering except in individual show. Preference will be given to ponies ridden in a snaffle bridle. *Riders* in this class may not compete in any other showing class except for Classes 9, 10 and 11 and (if eligible) Classes 5 and 6.
- CLASS 8 **MINI CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 5-7.
- CLASS 9 **VETERAN PONY** - Open to registered and unregistered ponies not exceeding 148cm, aged 16 years and over.
- CLASS 10 **RIDDEN COLOURED PONY** – Open to registered ponies. Riders age to conform to usual age/height restrictions
- CLASS 11 **FIRST RIDDEN/NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY**- Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm. Rider born in or after 1998 and ponies with 0-15 points riders born in or after 1996. *Pony/rider combinations* in this class may not compete in any other showing class except classes 7, 9 and 10 and, if eligible, classes 6 and 7.
- CLASS 12 **WORKING HUNTER PONY** – Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm. Rider born in or after 1996.
- CLASS 13 **NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY**- Open to All ponies exceeding 128cm not exceeding 148cm foaled in or after 2000 and ponies exceeding 128cm, not exceeding 148cm foaled before 2000 with 0-15 points which have not placed 1st or 2nd in any Working Hunter Pony class. Riders age to correspond with other class divisions.
- CLASS 14 **HUNTED WORKING HUNTER PONY** – Open to registered ponies not exceeding 148cm that have hunted with the Jersey Drag Hunt on at least three occasions between 9 October 2006 and 19 February 2008. Riders age to correspond with other class divisions. (Height approx 0.70m/0.75m)
- CLASS 15 **WORKING HUNTER PONY** - Open to ponies exceeding 128cm, not exceeding 138cm, rider born in or after 1994 and ponies exceeding 138cm, not exceeding 148cm, rider born in or after 1992. If there are sufficient entries, this class will be split into ponies not exceeding and ponies exceeding 138cm. Otherwise a trophy will be presented to the highest placed 138cm pony, which will then be eligible for Class 16.
- CLASS 16 **WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 11-15

- CLASS 17 **OPEN COB** - Open to registered horses and ponies.
- CLASS 18 **OPEN RIDING HORSE** – Open to Registered horses - This class may be divided if sufficient entries.
- CLASS 19 **OPEN COLOURED HORSE** – Open to registered horses
- CLASS 20 **RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 17-19.
- CLASS 21 **YOUNG SHOW HUNTER** - Open to registered horses foaled in 2002, 2003 or 2004.
- CLASS 22 **SMALL SHOW HUNTER** - Open to registered horses not exceeding 158cm
- CLASS 23 **LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER** - Open to registered horses capable of carrying up to 12st 7lbs.
- CLASS 24 **MIDDLEWEIGHT HUNTER** - Open to registered horses capable of carrying over 12st 7lbs.
- CLASS 25 **HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP**-Open to 1st and 2nd prize winner's in classes 21-24.
- CLASS 26 **VETERAN HORSE** - Open to registered and unregistered horses, aged 16 years and over
- CLASS 27 **NOVICE WORKING HUNTER** - Open to ALL registered horses foaled in or after 2002 **and** registered horses foaled before 2002 with 0-15 BSJA points which have not placed 1st or 2nd in any Working Hunter Class
- CLASS 28 **HUNTED WORKING HUNTER** – Open to registered and unregistered horses that have hunted with the Jersey Drag Hunt on at least three occasions between 9 October 2006 and 19 February 2008. (Ht approx 0.80m/0.85m)
- CLASS 29 **SMALL WORKING HUNTER** - Open to registered horses not exceeding 158cm.
- CLASS 30 **LARGE WORKING HUNTER** - Open to registered horses exceeding 158cm.
- CLASS 31 **WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners in Classes 27-30.

- CLASS 33 **128cm SMALL OPEN JUMPING** – Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm, riders born in or after 1996. Table A7

- CLASS 34 **128CM OPEN JUMPING** – Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm. Rider born in or after 1996. Table A7.

- CLASS 35 **JERSEY JUNIOR TRAILBLAZER** - Open to junior jumping and junior competitive non-jumping members, riders born in or after 1991. Open to registered and unregistered ponies. Riders' ages must follow the usual rules for the height of pony ridden. Table A7. **Entry fee: £5** (0.70m)
- CLASS 36 **JUNIOR JD JUMPING** - Open to ponies with 0-33 points. Rider born in or after 1992. Table A7.

- CLASS 37 **128CM CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to ponies not exceeding 128cm, riders born in or after 1996.
