Notes regarding the Show

1. The organising committee reserve the right to refuse any entry and amalgamate any class should there be insufficient entries.
2. The organising committee or BSJA accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show, howsoever caused.
3. Local competitors taking part in the Show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey.
4. **All** Horses/Ponies, including visiting ones, must be four years and over and registered with BSJA Jersey, or BSJA Guernsey and ridden by members in accordance with the BSJA Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules. Visiting Riders from outside the Channel Islands must take out Visiting Membership at a cost of £10, valid for this show only.
5. All BSJA Rules from the 2007 Rule Book and 2007 Local Rules.
6. **Entries Night** At BSJA Clubhouse from 7.30pm until 9.00pm on 13th August 2008. Please bring completed Entry Forms, which must include name and telephone number of a helper. Late entries will be taken on the day at a charge of £3.00 over and above the normal entry fee.
7. ALL TROPHIES to be returned to BSJA Clubhouse on 13th August 2008 between 7.30pm and 9.00pm.
8. Lists of qualifying horses and ponies will be on display in the Clubhouse. **Competitors must enter the Grade in which they jumped their last double clear round, with the exception of 128cm ponies qualifying in Nursery which may enter one only of Class 5, 6 or 7 in accordance with Pony's points and Horses qualifying with 0-33 points, who may enter class 16 or Class 30.** In the event that only one horse/pony is entered in a Show Jumper of the Year Class that horse/pony must jump two rounds without being eliminated to be awarded the Trophy & Prize Money.
9. Horses and ponies may enter a maximum of 3 classes per day

COMPETITION RULES

Rules for Championship Classes . run under Table A9. At the conclusion of the first round, all clear rounds or, if there are less than 8 clear rounds, those 8 with the least faults in the first round will qualify to go forward to the jump-off. If there is a tie for 8th place, the fastest competitor will qualify. The order of going in the jump-off will be in reverse order of penalties (and time from the first round, in the case of equality of faults). Final placings will be determined by adding together faults incurred in both rounds. In case of equality of faults, the fastest time in the jump-off will determine the final placings. Lower placings for competitors not taking part in the jump-off will depend on the faults and time (in the case of equality) in the first round.

Rules for Grand Prix Classes - This is a three round competition. All horses/ponies jumping clear in the first round or, if there are fewer than 8 clear rounds, the 8 horses/ponies with the least number of faults go forward to the second round, carrying any faults incurred with them. Round two is jumped over a puissance-type course of single fences, not against the clock. Horses/ponies with the highest number of faults in the first round will jump first, followed by those with the next highest and so on. If there is equality of faults after the second round, there will be a jump-off over a shortened first course. Lower placings will be decided first on the total number of faults, then on the time taken in the first round.
